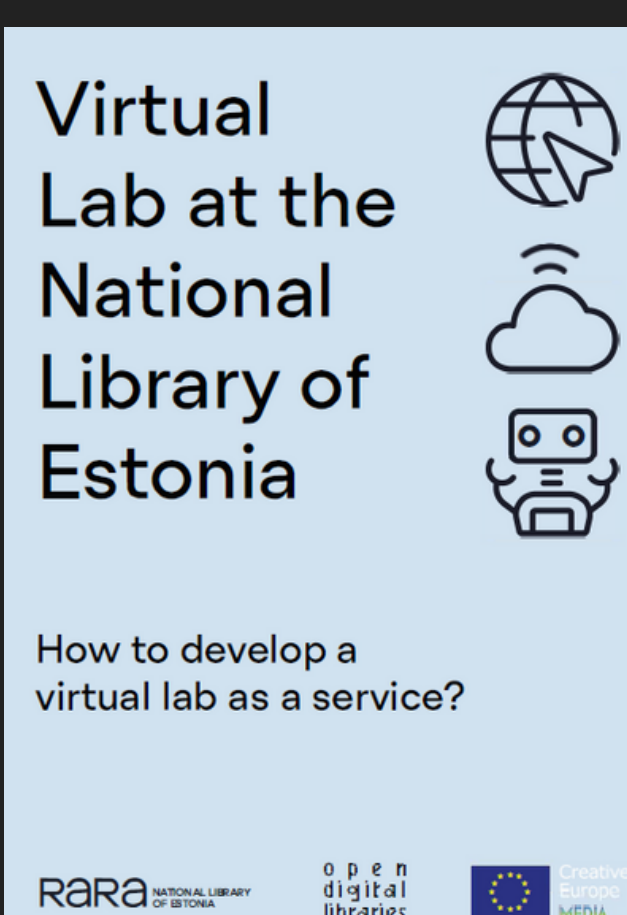
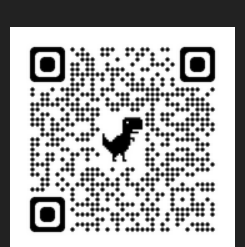

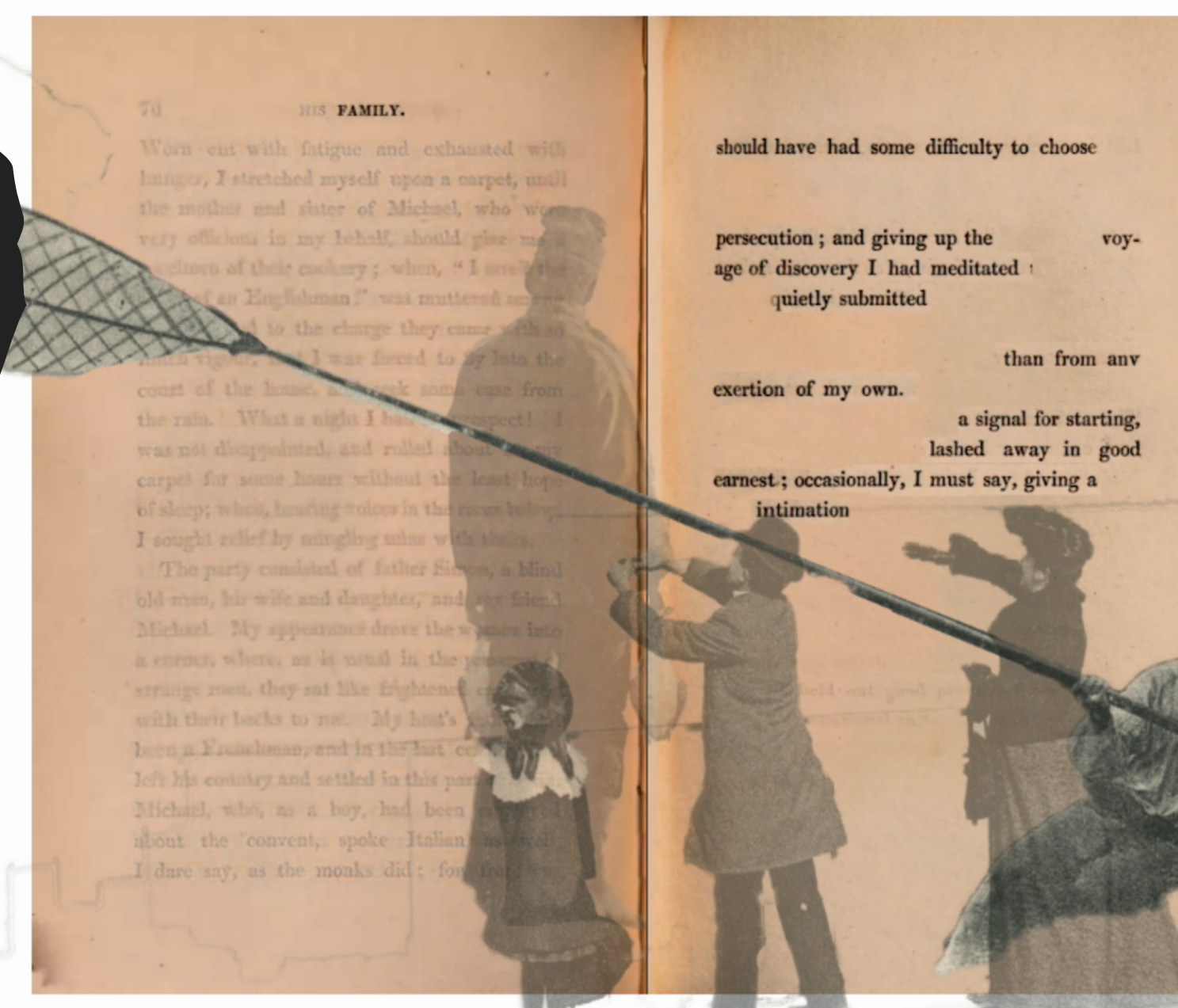
LESSONS LEARNED

- ★ Organise interesting and inspiring Kick-offs and have fun!

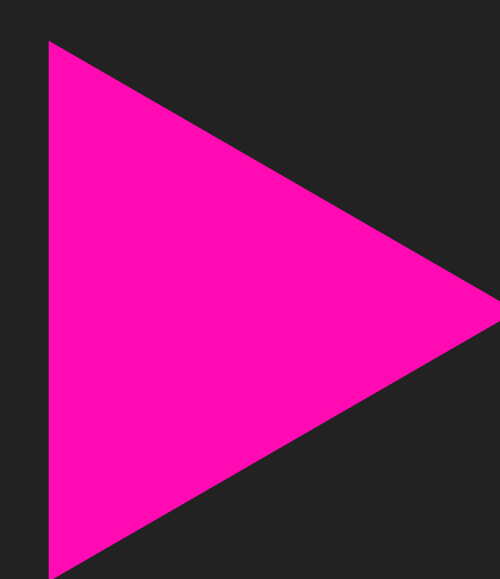


GOALS COMPLETED
